Who can use the online application for enrolment?

Germans and applicants with equal status to Germans:

The possibility to apply for enrolment online is available to all applicants for all applicants. Only for admitted students in the 1st semester of Medicine, Dentistry and Pharmacy B.Sc. Regio Chimica, as well as in higher semesters of Master's programmes, this option is not available. In these cases, please use the paper application ("matriculation documents", next section).

International applicants:

The option to apply for enrolment online is available for all applicants.

Applicants who are already enrolled at the University of Freiburg are requested to make a change of subject/programme during the enrolment period. (Application for change of subject/programme for download)

- Your printed application will list any other documents or proofs that are required for enrolment. Please read the application carefully and submit the listed documents in full for enrolment.
